
Puzzle

Instructions: Write the words defined by the numbered clues in the correspondingly numbered rectangles, one letter to a square. Letters that fall in numbered squares should be entered in the correspondingly number squares of the grid on the next page. Letters that fall in the blank squares of any two adjacent rectangles should be anagrammed to form a new word to be entered in the rectangle below them where, once again, letters that fall in numbered squares are to be entered in the grid on the next page, while those that fall in blank squares should be anagrammed to form a new word . . . and so on. Anagrammed words, all but the last, are defined by unnumbered clues in random order. Correctly completed, the lower grid will contain the names of entities sharing a characteristic specified by the last anagrammed but unclued word.
