Instructions: Guess the words defined by the cryptic clues (words vary in length from four to eight letters and include three proper names and one foreign word), then enter them in the grid one after another in the same order as their clues, starting in the upper left corner. Across words that don't end at the right margin continue on the next line below; down words that don't end at the bottom margin continue in the next column to the right. Fifteen across words won't fit in the grid unless one of their letters is omitted. Those fifteen letters, taken in order, spell a phrase that suggests how ten down words are to be treated before they are entered in the grid.
