Across words that don't end at the right continue on the next row, and down words that don't end at the bottom continue in the next column. Four cells in the grid must accommodate two letters each, one from an across word and one from a down word. In addition, eight across words and seven down words won't fit in the grid unless one of their letters is omitted. Those fifteen letters, taken in order as they occur in across and down words, spell a three-word phrase related to the puzzle's title.
