
Puzzle # 67 – December 2006 "O What Fun"

Instructions: Guess the words defined by the cryptic clues (words vary in length from four to nine letters and include four proper names), then enter them in the grid one after another in the same order as their clues, starting in the upper left corner. Across words that don't end at the right continue on the next row, and down words that don't end at the bottom continue in the next column. Eleven across words and ten down words won't fit in the grid unless one of their letters is removed. Those twenty-one letters, taken in order, spell a six-word phrase related to the mystery entry and to the title of this puzzle. I thank Kevin Wald for help with the clues.
